


## A simple guide to RSN online spreadsheets – Broadband data analysis

The 'Broadband Data Analysis' spreadsheet uses a drop down list to select the authority of interest. For the selected authority, the average sync speed, the total ranking for all authorities, and an urban/rural ranking is provided.

To select the authority, please follow the instructions below:

1<sup>st</sup>. Move the mouse pointer to the green highlighted cell containing an authority name, and select this cell.

2<sup>nd</sup>. Once the cell containing an authority name is selected, a small grey square with a blue arrow head will appear at the bottom right corner of the green cell.

Moving the mouse pointer across to this grey box, click again and the list of options drops down.

3<sup>rd</sup>. The full set of authorities on the drop down list can be viewed by using the scroll bar at the side of the list.
